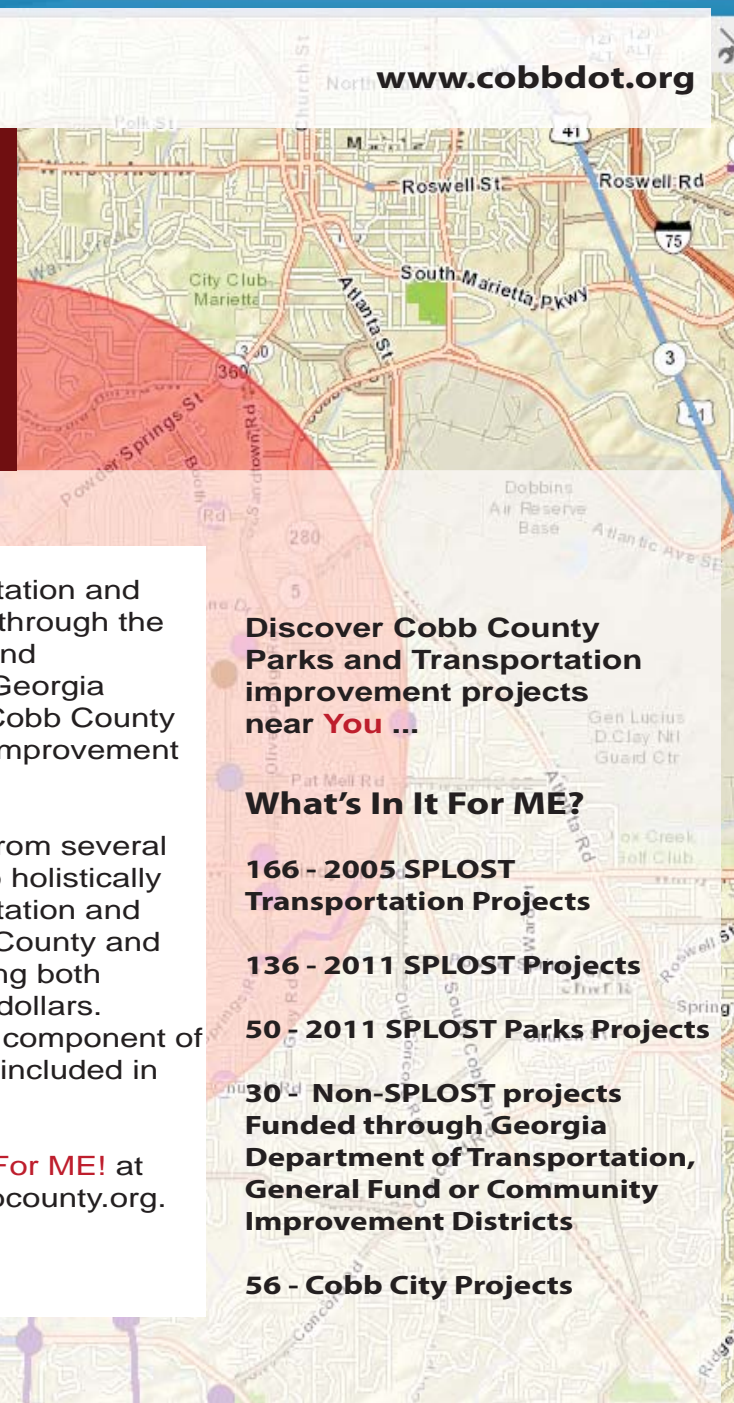

What's In it For Me? is an **online GIS web map** that, at a click on the map or search by address, allows you to get a listing of transportation and parks projects within a five mile buffer of the point clicked or address entered.

To create What's In It For Me?, existing GIS technology and data was utilized. Search for projects near where you live, work, or play on any device – desktop, laptop, tablet or smart phone.

When a location is clicked or address entered, projects highlighted are indicated by a **red circular five mile buffer**. Project totals and links to project fact sheets, if available for that project, are listed on the left hand side of the map. If the project is in the 2011 SPLOST program there is a hyperlink to the project's fact sheet which showcases more detailed project information such as budget, schedule and contact information.

Discover Cobb County transportation and parks projects near you funded through the 2005 SPLOST, 2011 SPLOST and non-SPLOST sources such as Georgia Department of Transportation, Cobb County General Fund and Community Improvement Districts.

Viewing Cobb County projects from several different programs allows you to holistically see the more than 430 transportation and parks projects funded by Cobb County and Cobb's six cities since 2005 using both SPLOST and non-SPLOST tax dollars. Although Resurfacing is a large component of the SPLOST programs, it is not included in this web map.
